- **Have your volunteer form filled out** and turn into the PTO Table as you enter the gym.
- **Have your student's required Locker and Agenda Fees (and annual family PTO Donation) prepared by doing one of the following:**
 1. **Pay on-line by 11 pm, August 1** with Credit/Debit Card payment or Paypal at www.whitwatermiddlepto.org . Bring a confirmation of your online payment in the enclosed white envelope and drop off at the PTO table as you enter the gym for Meet The Teacher.
 2. **OR, place your payment of cash or check** in the enclosed white envelope and drop off at the PTO table as you enter the gym for Meet The Teacher.

PLEASE NOTE: Credit/Debit Card and Paypal payments will only be accepted on-line through 11 pm August 1. We will NOT be taking credit/debit card and paypal payments at Meet the Teacher. You may pay with cash and/or check after 11 pm on August 1.

SIXTH GRADERS:

- After paying required locker and agenda fees, 6th Grade Students will receive their locker assignment with combination when they meet their homeroom teacher. The 6th Grade Students will be able to practice opening their locker.
- 6th Grade Students will receive supply lists and information from each of their core teachers. Be sure to meet them all.
- On the first day of school, 6th Grade Students will receive their agenda, class schedule, take a tour of the school and will be given assigned time to get their lockers, supplies and books organized.

SEVENTH and EIGHTH GRADERS:

- After paying required locker and agenda fees, 7th & 8th grade students will receive supply lists and other information from each of their core teachers. Be sure to meet them all.
- On the first day of school, 7th & 8th Grade Students will receive their locker assignment with combination, agenda, class schedule and will be given assigned time to get their lockers, supplies and books organized.
